



Ladies Section Competition Information

Rule 1

A player must register her intention to play by signing the Competition Sheet before playing in the competition and pay the competition fee.

Any player withdrawing from a competition after the start sheet has been posted in the professional's shop is liable to pay the competition fee.

Any player cancelling from a drawn competition once the draw has been made is liable to pay the competition fee.

Rule 2

To qualify to win prizes and trophies in competitions, ladies must hold a Competition handicap. Ladies with Non-Competition handicaps may enter competitions in order to regain their Competition handicap status.

Ladies entering knockout competitions must ensure that they have a Competition handicap before playing the first round match. A maximum handicap of 36 MAY be applied for prize purposes to 18 hole competitions and to 9 hole trophy competitions. All 9 hole and fun competitions will have a maximum handicap of 54.

Disqualification

Members are reminded that disqualification shall result from:

1. Failure to sign the competition sheet.
2. Failure to pay competition fee.
3. Failure to sign and have signed by their marker their scorecard.
4. Failure to return their scorecard within 15 minutes after the end of the competition.
5. Failure to enter their handicap on their scorecard or to enter a higher handicap than their current playing handicap.

Presentations

Prize winners are expected to attend presentations themselves or nominate someone to attend on their behalf otherwise the prize may be forfeited. The Committee may waive this rule in exceptional circumstances.
